



What is Hazardous Waste and what do we do with it?

Hazardous waste comes in many forms: antifreeze, batteries, oil filters, propane tanks, tires.

It is also personal care products: alcohol-based lotions, nail polish and remover non-empty aerosol cans.

Cleaning products: ammonia-based cleaners, abrasive powders, bleach, drain cleaners, floor polish.

You will also find at that website where and how to dispose of these items. You ARE NOT to put them in the large item enclosure where some members have been doing. If you have used tires to dispose of, you must have a car where you can drive to get rid of them. By the way, the disposal site for tires is 188 Bermondsey Road. All other items can be left at 3350 Victoria Park Ave., but you will need to find out the times and days.
